CU Systems and applications



An overview of the main information systems and tools used at Charles University — their purpose, login and basic orientation.

Software, licenses



Available software products for students and employees, license terms and installation instructions.

Computer Management and IT



How computer management works at the CU, where to look for assistance when solving technical problems and what rules apply to service equipment.

Telecommunications and infrastructure



Networks, connections, VPNs, telephony and other infrastructure services important for reliable IT operations.

Cloud services



Microsoft 365 tools and other approved cloud services — what they offer, who they are intended for and how to use them safely.

Servers and databases



Hosting, server and database management options provided centrally and by faculty — in a clear and comprehensible form.

Information for IT administrators



Specific information, technical documentation and contacts intended for management and technical roles.
